Asbestos Management Plan

Official statement on the location of asbestos and availability of the Asbestos Management Plan:

On October 22, 1986, President Ronald Reagan signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). These regulations were finalized in 1987. It required the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA): 1) to issue regulations requiring all private and public elementary and secondary schools to be inspected for asbestos; 2) to take action in the event that any asbestos-containing material was determined to be a possible health hazard; 3) to develop a management plan for each school which would be publicly available and which would contain detailed results of the inspection and records of any actions taken by the school with respect to asbestos.

This notice is to inform you that in compliance with regulation 40 CFR Part 763.84(c), a copy of the Asbestos Management Plan for Bible Center Christian School is available for inspection. To inspect this document, you should contact Mr. Michael Reynolds in the school office or call (304) 346-0222.

Regular six month periodic surveillance of the asbestos containing materials will be conducted during the months of April and October. If any asbestos response actions (e.g. removal, repair, enclosure, encapsulation or operations and maintenance) take place in the school, notices will be posted.
