I. He Invites Our Fellowship (Exodus 24:1-2)

- A. God's heart desires fellowship
- B. God's holiness denies fellowship

II. He Initiates Our Fellowship (Exodus 24:3-8)

- A. By grace
 - 1. Obtained - by blood
 - 2. Maintained - by faithfulness
- B. Through faith
 - 1. Applied
 - 2. Accepted

III. He Involves Himself in Fellowship (Exodus 24:9-11)

- A. Available to all
- B. Available in person
