Special Missions Offering**
Our special missions project offering
for January and February will be in
conjunction with the Dreisbachs, our
partners in the Philippines. On November
8, 2013, Typhoon Haiyan devastated
several islands in the Philippines and
killed thousands. A critical component
of the extended recovery effort is clean
drinking water in these areas. The
materials for a simple water filtration
system, that can be made by the people
themselves, can be purchased for about
\$20. This filter will provide clean water
for up to 5 families. The systems will
allow for churches in these areas to be
an integral part of the recovery and will
allow them to show and share the truth
of the gospel as they train the people
on how to make these systems. Let's see
how many systems we can provide in
order to be the hands and feet of Jesus
in the Philippines. Please mark your check
