Galatians 5:13-26

God's <u>Spirit frees</u> us to become what God's <u>law</u> could never <u>force</u> us to be: <u>Like Jesus</u>.

1. The Spirit Frees Us to Love Like Jesus Loved (13-15)

- A. Humbly <u>serving</u> others is the antidote to <u>self-indulgence</u>. (13)
- B. Constantly <u>prioritizing</u> others is the antidote to <u>self-destruction</u>. (14-15)

2. The Spirit Frees Us to <u>Live</u> Like Jesus <u>Lived</u> (16-26)

- A. The struggle between the <u>flesh</u> and the <u>Spirit</u> is a <u>good</u> thing. (<u>16-18</u>)
 - · If you think you don't <u>struggle</u>, look <u>out</u>.
 - If you think you can't <u>change</u>, look <u>up</u>.
- B. The change from the <u>acts</u> of the <u>flesh</u> to the <u>fruit</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> is a <u>great</u> thing. (19-26)
 - When we rely on the <u>external</u> standards of <u>religious</u> codes, we <u>fail</u> to <u>become</u> like Jesus.

The result: The flesh wins!

· When we rely on the <u>internal</u> working of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, we <u>become</u> like Jesus.

The result: The fruit shows!
