We desperately need truth. (John 8:31-32, 44)

Reasons We Believe the Bible Is God's Inspired and Infallible Word: (2 Kings 22:10-13)

a. Continuity

- Written by 40 different authors from various backgrounds over a 1500-year span on 3 continents
- 66 separate books
- One message: God's redemption of mankind
- <u>63,799 cross references</u> throughout the Bible

b. Fulfilled Prophecy (Isaiah 46:9-10)

- 300+ Messianic prophecies
 - » Jesus' crucifixion (Isaiah 53; Psalm 22)
 - » Daniel: Messiah will begin His public ministry 483 years after decree to rebuild Jerusalem (*Daniel 9:25-26*)
 - » Daniel: Messiah "cut off" (killed) prior to the second destruction of Jerusalem (AD 70)
- Moses: First Jewish exile (<u>Deuteronomy 28:49-57</u>)
- Isaiah: Jews return and rebuild Jerusalem (Isaiah 44:28-45:3)

c. Historical Accuracy

- Hittite culture
- Tower of Babel
- Sodom & Gomorrah
- Luke's writings (Luke; Acts)

d. Scientific Knowledge

- Hydrological/water cycle (<u>Job 36:27-28</u>)
- The Earth hangs in empty space. (Job 26:7)
- Time and space had a beginning. (Genesis 1)
- The Second Law of Thermodynamics (Psalm 102:25-26)
- The Earth is a sphere. (Isaiah 40:22)
- Blood is necessary for life. (Leviticus 17:11)
- Handling of disease and germs (Deuteronomy 23:12-14)

e. Transformed Lives (2 Peter 1:16)

- Countless lives radically changed.
- The apostles sealed their testimony with their lives.
