1. The Gospel is **Collective** and **Communal**.

- A. The gospel is a "we" thing. (1 Peter 2:9)
- B. The gospel is a "whole world" thing. (Hebrews 12:1)

2. The Gospel is Cosmic and Ceaseless. (Philippians 1:6; Revelation 21:1-2)

3. The Gospel is Central.

- A. In the Old Testament
 - <u>Promises</u> Israel existed for the sake of the Gospel (<u>Genesis 3:15, 12:1-3, 17:19, 28:14, 49:10...</u>)
 - <u>Positions</u> Prophets, Priests (Aaron), and Kings (David) = types and shadows
 - · Pictures Clothing Adam & Eve, the ark, exodus, Passover...
 - Prophecies (Isaiah 6:9-10, 7:14, 8:14, 9:1-2, 53, Micah 5:2...)
 - Psalms The heartbeat of the people of Israel (Psalm 2, 67, 117:1)
- B. In the New Testament (Hebrews 12:1)
 - The Goal of Paul's preaching (1 Corinthians 1:23)
 - The Purpose of Paul's life and ministry (Colossians 1:28-29)
- C. Throughout all eternity (Revelation 5:1-14, 21:3)

The Gospel is the central message of the whole Bible and of all eternity! Our response to the Gospel is to live out the Gospel.
